I'm looking forward to your first book presentation!

The first thing you need to do is choose a book you really like and read it. You may want to read it once, and you can read it again if you would like to. After you read your book, then think about what you liked about it. What was most exciting? What was the best part? Now, tell us! How? It's easy!!!

Tell us, your friends, about your book in a short (3-5 minute) presentation. Do it any way you like! You can dress up and act like a character in your book. You can draw a picture of something that happened. You can make something, bring something from home, or do any kind of project you want to to tell us about what you liked in the book. You can do anything you like!

At the Book Club, step up, tell us your name, the book's title, author, and illustrator, and show us the book. Tell us (or ask us to guess) the genre (kind) of book you read.

Please speak loudly, use expression (that means look scary, or sleepy, or happy...whatever the characters did in your book), and look at the audience (us!). You may even ask us questions if you like.

Then tell us about the characters and the plot (what happens in the story)...but don't tell anyone the ending! They can read the book themselves to find out!

And, please, read a little bit of your favorite part of the book.

You don't need to be nervous. You're just telling us about something you really liked, just like talking about the presents you got for your birthday. And...you can make notes on an index card and clip it to the back of your book so you won't forget what you wanted to say!

Before you come to the Book Club, practice your presentation in front of your parents, grandparents, or even your dog! This is fun and so easy!
